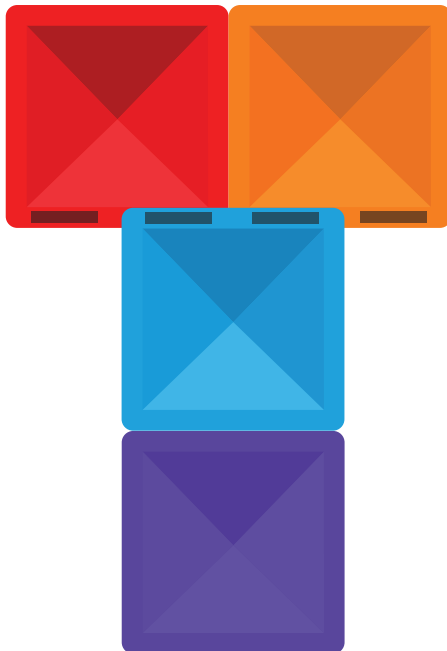




CONNETIX[®]
